# Ms. Mabel CHU Senior Community Relations Officer Hong Kong Business Ethics Development Centre

Mabel has been working in the Community Relations Department of the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) for over 20 years. Mabel has accrued Throughout the years, experience in liaising with various sectors and giving corruption prevention seminars for personnel from government and private sectors. Mabel currently serves in the Hong Kong Business Development Centre of the ICAC as Senior Community Relations Officer to promulgate ethics and anti-corruption messages to the business community of Hong Kong.

#### Joint Financial Intelligence Unit (JFIU) Hong Kong Police Force

"JFIU" stands for the Joint Financial Intelligence Unit. The Unit was set up in 1989. Pursuant to section 25A(1) of the Organized and Serious Crimes Ordinance ("OSCO") Cap. 455 and the Drug (Recovery of Proceeds) Ordinance Trafficking ("DTROP") Cap. 405, as well as section 12(1) of the (Anti-Terrorism Nations Ordinance ("UNATMO") Cap. 575, where a person knows or suspects that any property (a) in whole or in part directly or indirectly represents any person's proceeds of, (b) was used in connection with, or (c) is intended to be used in connection with drug trafficking or an indictable offence; or that any property is terrorist property, the person shall as soon as it is reasonable for him to do so, file a suspicious transaction report ("STR") with JFIU.

The JFIU, as the name implies, is jointly run by staff members of the Hong Kong Police Force and the Hong Kong Customs & Excise Department. The JFIU manages the suspicious transaction reporting regime for Hong Kong and its role is to receive, analyse STRs and to disseminate them to the appropriate law enforcement agencies in or outside Hong Kong, or financial intelligence units worldwide.

#### Ms. Natalie POON Senior Personal Data Officer Privacy Commissioner for Personal Data, Hong Kong

Ms. Poon is currently a Senior Personal Data Officer in the Legal, Policy and Research Division of the PCPD. She is currently responsible for promoting the adoption of Privacy Management Programmes in organisations as a strategic framework to protect personal data privacy. She has also served in the Complaints Division of the PCPD for over ten years and had accumulated professional experience in complaint handling and investigation of cases under the purview of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance.

Ms. Poon holds a Master degree in Social Work as well as a Master of Law in Common Law from the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
